- **Informational Forms:** Online Parent Password, Lunch Price Information, School Calendar, and Assignment Book (3rd/4th grade only). The Student Supply List and Parent/Student Handbook are available to view on our website. Contact the school office if you would like a paper copy.
- Please note that supplies will not be shared and students will keep all supplies in their backpacks.
- Backpacks will not go back and forth between school and home to limit the spread of germs.
