

Press Release – LqPV Community Survey Results – May 13, 2019

The highlights from the community survey results shared with the public during a special board meeting held on Monday, May 13 are as follows:

- 899 respondents completed the survey. (page 2)
- 68% of all respondents indicated the board should continue to invest in/upgrade all schools. (page 17)
- 62% of all respondents indicated they would support a plan that provides funding to update the existing elementary schools; 23% said they wouldn't and 15% were undecided. (page 21)
- 72% of all respondents said they would not support a plan that provides funding to consolidate to one campus; 17% said yes and 12% were undecided. (page 24)
- The first seven high school projects on the survey were supported by a majority of respondents. Scores of 5.5 or better indicate that a majority of respondents in that category support the projects listed. (page 26)
- There was little support for adding another gym or a fieldhouse at the high school site. (page 29)
- The respondents indicated they would support a referendum in the range of \$24-\$25 million. (page 32)
