## FREE / REDUCED MEALS

**Application for Educational Benefits** can be submitted anytime during the school year and families may qualify for free or reduced price meals if the total household income is within eligibility guidelines, or if the child receives MFIP or food stamps. Children living in foster homes and students whose families have been temporarily displaced and are living with friends or relatives may also qualify. ## Meal Charging Policy

The purpose of having a meal charging policy is to establish consistent, clear meal account procedures throughout the school district. We encourage all parents / guardians to be responsible for monitoring the balance on their student lunch account and meal payments.

1. **PREPAYMENT** for all meals is **REQUIRED** for all students.
2. We do not encourage meal charging, but understand that it occasionally happens. Meal charging will be allowed as a courtesy to families, but repayment is expected for all charged meals.
3. When lunch account balances reach a negative **\$15.00** an e-mail notification will be sent out.
4. Delinquent account balances may result in not allowing any more meals to be charged and meals to be purchased on a cash only basis or an alternative meal will be served. Every effort will be made to help any family that is in need.
